Information Gathered

Set up: Approx total floorspace 160sq m/1720sq ft.

Opened Jan 2019; co-working seen as commercial business therefore does not attract Govt. grant; no financial support from CDC; development of facilities self-funded.

Does not appear to suffer competition from the Chichester Community Development Trust (CCDT), Freedom Works (this provides more individual office type accommodation), or Chichester Enterprise Centre – CEC (Base Point). CEC is joint venture with CDC and is moving toward providing more and more co-working facilities.

Types of membership/charges set out below. Approx 100 members comprising: 20% 24/7; 40% 40 to 80 hours pm; 40% Community members. Emphasis is on creative freelance occupiers who benefit from co-working. Source of users covers Arundel/Midhurst/Petersfield as well as Chichester and immediate environs.

Space for up to provision of 40 hot desks but most used for co-working; no computers provided; 2 x Broadband provision of which 1 x 1GB superfast bb; 2 x confidential phone booths. Potential for extensive expansion – see floorspace plan.

Aim: to provide 3 or 4 course events pm; helps support CCDT with access to courses; attendance between 5 & 15 people.

Parking: none on site; public car parks within walking distance.

Open: Mon-Fri 08:00 – 18:00 staffed; open 24/7 for dedicated desks (12) with building entry fob access and storage lockers.

Staff: 2 x co-founders with possibly + 1.

Facilities/size: Boardroom: approx. 12sq m (4m x 3.m)(approx. 13sq ft); Meeting Room: 9sq m currently not available as sub let as office to company for 6 months.
